

### Japanese Language Course Class Registration

*Japanese Language Course classes at the International Institute for Japanese Language Education are offered at different proficiency levels (beginner to pre-advanced) and in three varying intensiveness modes. Classes are carried out in groups with a small number of students by our experienced Japanese language instructors aiming not only at providing the students with the necessary knowledge, but also at fostering real life Japanese proficiency. We hope that through our Japanese language program and their study abroad students in Japan, our students will be able to see the world from a new, wider perspective as truly globally oriented young people.*
